COVID-19 Booster Vaccination

Your appointment is at the following vaccination centre: **Mid Devon Healthcare Primary Care Network Vaccination Centre, Lords Meadow Leisure Centre, Lords Meadow Industrial Estate, Commercial Road, Crediton. EX17 1ER**

We wish to ensure no vaccine is wasted during this important time in the pandemic. **We need you to accept your appointment** so we avoid any unfilled slots during our clinic.

Please do not attend your appointment if you, or a household member is experiencing any COVID symptoms, or you are currently isolating.

We have sent you this letter as you have been identified as a priority for receiving a COVID-19 booster vaccine.

The vaccine should be offered to you no earlier than six months after completion of the first course of vaccination.

You should have received two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine to be eligible for a booster dose. We strongly recommend you have the booster to ensure you have maximum protection from the virus ahead of the winter months.

About the COVID-19 booster vaccine

The COVID-19 booster vaccine is only available from the NHS and is free of charge.

You can also ask about it when you book or discuss it with a health professional when you attend your appointment.

Vaccination Site

There is very limited car parking at the Leisure Centre, this is further restricted due to the opening of the leisure centre, we ask you to consider arranging someone to bring you to your appointment where possible.

If you are driven to your appointment, you will be guided by Marshalls to the 'Drop off point' in the main car park, the driver will then be guided to move to the collection car park. Please advise the driver that they may expect to wait approximately 15 minutes.

For patients who may require transport, details are available on our practice website under practice updates.

If you are unable to attend alone, you may bring one person with you to assist you.

During the vaccination delivery we will maintain the range of measures we have in place to keep you safe from COVID-19. Staff giving the vaccine will be wearing personal protective equipment and will abide by all our cleaning and disinfection requirements.

- Please ensure you turn up on time for your arrival time, not early or late. You will not be able to enter the building until your allocated time slot.
